1. Discuss and consider adoption of Resolution R03-2025-446 to amend the Texpool Authorized Representatives.

Council Member Tina Pace made the motion to Approve Resolution R03-2025-446; second by Council Member Scott Gilbreath, council voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 7-0.

2. Discuss and consider the adoption of Ordinance **03-2025-557**, amending Chapter 2 "Administration," Article IV "Boards and Commissions," Division 4 "Library Board," of the Code of Ordinances, adding an alternate member, and revising the established meeting day on which the Library Board shall meet.

Council Member Matt Foster made the motion to Approve Ordinance 03-2025-557; second by Council Member Scott Gilbreath, council voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 7-0.

3. Discuss appointing a Council Member liaison for the Library Board.

Council Member Jesse Johnson made the motion to Nominate Tina Pace to serve as the liaison to the Library Board; second by Council Member Jim Hirth, council voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 7-0.

Advisory Boards and Commissions

1. Discuss and consider appointing Rhiannone Harrison to the Library Board, Place 3, for the remainder of the term ending June 30, 2027.

Council Member Tina Pace made the motion to Nominate Rhiannone Harrison to Place 3 of the Library Board for the remainder of the term ending June 30, 2027; second by Council Member Jim Hirth, council voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 7-0.
