1. Discussion of proposed operational changes for the BBQ Competition in November 2026

Downtown Coordinator Julie Hepler addressed the City Council regarding the upcoming BBQ Festival. She explained that the event coordinator is requesting to change the event from a ticketed admission to a free public event, while continuing to offer VIP Experience tickets for purchase. Ms. Hepler stated that, because this is the first year of the festival, staff believes offering free admission will help attract greater attendance and increase community interest. She also noted that eliminating general admission will eliminate the need for perimeter fencing, resulting in cost savings for the event.
