5. Discuss and consider adoption of Resolution R02-2026-479 declaring certain property as surplus to the City's needs; authorizing its sale; providing an effective date and authorizing staff to place surplus items for the city for auction.

6. Discuss and consider approval of the annual contract (March 1, 2026, through February 28, 2027) for the fire and ambulance service with Saint Francis Village and authorize the Mayor to execute said contract.

Council Member Tina Pace made the motion to Approve the annual contract for fire and ambulance service with Saint Francis Village; second by Council Member Jesse Johnson, council voted unanimously to approve the motion as presented. Motion carried 6-0.

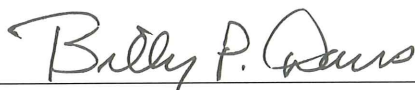

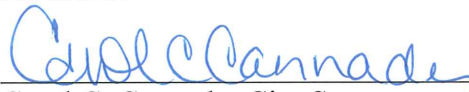
